MINUTES

The Geneva City Council met in work session on September 10, 2024, at 4:30 p.m. in the Council room at City Hall. Members present were Mayor David Hayes and Council Members Rufus Lee, Rich Bixby, Mike Fountain, and Daniel L. Coleman. Council Members Freddy McCoy, Kim Gillespie, and Ryan Tidwell were absent. Also present were City Clerk/Treasurer Lisa Johnson.

Council reviewed a proposed budget and discussed department requests and department operations.

Recommended changes to the budget included the following:

- 5% cost of living raise for all permanent full-time employees and permanent part-time employees working weekly that have been employed at least six months by the end of September
- Increase of \$2,400.00 to the SEACAP allocation
- An additional police officer position
- Radio for Animal Control \$1,000.00
- Two recommendations for a salary adjustment for the Recreation Director was made. One was a \$15,000 salary adjustment and the second was a \$10,000.00 increase in addition to COLA
- Pole barn for the recreation department \$7,000.00
- Additional \$2,500.00 for books for the Library
- Change the starting salary for the full-time Library Aide to \$10.50 per hour
- Adjust garbage collection fees to reflect a \$.24 per account per month increase
- Increase starting salary of Paramedic by \$1.25 hour making the starting salary \$19.25 per hour
- Add \$200 per month stipend for Critical Care Paramedics
- Add \$60 stipend over 100 miles
- Cardiac Monitor \$12,525.00
