## ORDINANCE NUMBER 01-2022-02

AN ORDINANCE DATED THE  $20^{TH}$  DAY OF DECEMBER, 2021 ESTABLISHING A FOUR WAY STOP AT THE INTERSECTION OF NORTH SUNFLOWER STREET AND WEST CAMELLIA AVENUE.

- WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Geneva, Alabama recognizes the intersection at North Sunflower Street and West Camellia Avenue, constitutes a hazardous intersection; and
- 2. WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council of the City of Geneva, Alabama, that a four-way stop at said intersection could alleviate the traffic problem that now exists.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GENEVA, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That a four-way stop be placed at the intersection of North Sunflower Street and West Camellia Avenue.
- 2. This ordinance shall become effective on publication.
- 3. This Ordinance shall be published in the Geneva County Reaper, a newspaper published in Geneva County, Alabama as required by law.
