GENEVA CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING NOVEMBER 6, 2025 4:30 P.M.

MINUTES

The Geneva City Council met in special session on November 6, 2025, at 4:30 p.m. in the City Council room at City Hall. Members present were Mayor Hayes and Council Members Zack Dodson, Junior Mixon, Ronnie Baine, Rich Bixby, and Scott Stough. Council Members Rufus Lee and Sarah Tinsley were absent. Also present were City Clerk Lisa Johnson and City Attorney Jeff Gray.

Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order.

Council Member Dodson gave the invocation and Mayor Hayes led the pledge of allegiance.

Upon due public notice, bids were received for a resurfacing project using funds from a Rebuild Alabama grant and the City's Rebuild Alabama tax allocations. Bids received were based on unit quantities with low bid being determined off engineering estimates. Bids received were as follows:

Council Member Stough moved to award the bid to Southeast Construction Co. Inc. The motion was seconded by Council Member Baine and was approved by a four (4) to zero (0) vote with Mayor Hayes and Council Member Bixby abstaining.

Council Member Baine moved to authorize a contract with Southeast Construction Co. Inc. in the amount of \$418,318.00. The motion was seconded by Council Member Dodson and was approved by a four (4) to zero (0) vote with Mayor Hayes and Council Member Bixby abstaining.

Council Member Mixon moved to adopt a resolution authorizing acceptance of the Rebuild Alabama Grant and authorizing the Mayor to execute all documents pertaining to the project. The motion was seconded by Council Member Baine and was approved by a five (5) to zero (0) vote with Mayor Hayes abstaining.

Council Member Dodson moved to adopt a resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute an agreement with the Alabama Department of Transportation and all documents pertaining to a TAP sidewalk project. The motion was seconded by Council Member Stough and was approved by a five (5) to zero (0) vote with Mayor Hayes abstaining.

Council Member Stough moved to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Council Member Dodson. Council adjourned at 4:52 p.m.
