ORDINANCE NUMBER 07-2025-22

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 04-2021-03 DATED THE 5^{TH} DAY OF APRIL, 2021 AND REPEALING ANY OTHER ORDINANCE IN CONFLICT OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE, AND TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GENEVA ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

THAT ORDINANCE NO. <u>04-2021-03</u> is hereby enacted and amended as to Section 1 subset (c) and shall read as follows:

- Section 1. Definitions: the following words and terms when used in this ordinance shall have the meanings respectively described to them by this section unless the context indicates otherwise.
 - (c) "Garbage and Trash" shall be construed to mean and include all waste and discarded materials including rubbish and debris (but not including tires), waste and discarded food, animal and vegetable matter (but not including liquid waste) and waste paper, cans, glass, crockery, rags, ashes, cinders, brush, grass, weeds and cuttings from trees, lawns and gardens, when such substances are placed in garbage containers as hereinabove defined in sub-section (b) of Ordinance No. 04-2021-03. It shall be in violation of this ordinance to place or allow tires for garbage pick-up or to remain on any right-of-way.

Section 2. **PENALTIES.** Any person firm, association or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, on conviction, shall be fined not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00)

The invalidity or unenforceability of any particular provision of the Ordinance shall not affect any other provision, if any clause, sentence, section or provision of this ordinance is held invalid or inoperative or unenforceable, the remainder of the Ordinance NO. <u>04-2021-03</u> shall not be affected thereby.

This ordinance shall become effective once it has been posted for two consecutive weeks in three public places in the City.
