

ORDINANCE NUMBER 02-2023-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6.15 "DEFINITIONS" OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 08-2016-04 DATED THE 1ST DAY OF AUGUST, 2016 AND REPEALING AND ANY OTHER ORDINANCE IN CONFLICT OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE, AND TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GENEVA ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The following words, terms and phrases, when used in this article, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this section, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

Animal means and includes any horse, hog, cow, goat or any other animal of the equine, swine or bovine type of family.

Domesticated hens means female chickens that may, where permitted, be kept and maintained for the non-commercial production of eggs, education, companionship, or recreation. Other types of fowl and poultry shall not be considered domesticated hens.

Enclosure means the entire housed or fenced area where animals or fowl are confined.

Enforcement officer means the county health officer, animal control officer, or police officer.


Running at large means that such animal or fowl is off the controlled premises of the owner.

Zoning district means zoning districts as set out in the Code of Ordinances of the City of Geneva, Alabama.

2. That Section 6.15 of Ordinance Number 08-2016-04 dated the 1st day of August, 2016 be hereby amended along with any other ordinance repealed that which may be in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance.
3. The invalidity or unenforceability of any particular provision of the Ordinance shall not affect any other provision, if any clause, sentence, section or provision of this ordinance is held invalid or inoperative or unenforceable, the remainder of the ordinance shall not be affected thereby.
4. This ordinance shall become effective on publication.
5. The City Clerk is hereby directed to cause this ordinance to be published one time in the Geneva County Reaper, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Geneva, Alabama.
